

Dear All Saints Catholic School Families,

Welcome back to another great year of school! All 4th to 8th grade students are required to participate in COB (Choir, Orchestra or Band). Our band and orchestra program are sponsored by the CYO Catholic Youth Organization! To participate in band or orchestra there will be an additional cost of \$200.00 that can be paid in full or added to your monthly FACTS tuition fee. Choir is offered at no additional cost. In addition, we also offer an after school band for students 5th grade and up that have 2 or more years of experience. This will also be an additional charge of \$175.00 for the year. The fees for band and orchestra are to help cover the cost of equipment, music, and other expenses to conduct the program.

I would like to personally invite you to attend the **CYO Band & Orchestra Parent Information** meeting being held on **"Back to School Night"**. Dates and times for each campus will follow. At this meeting we will be accepting registrations. We will have lots of information about upcoming fundraisers and events, including concert dates. If you are unable to attend this meeting, please contact me ASAP. The registration deadline for all ensembles is Thursday, September 21st!

Instrument "Try-Its" will be conducted during Packet Pickup days and will also be scheduled for September 11th, 12th and 13th. You can go to our website to sign up for a time to come and try out different instruments.

Also, I would like to invite you to become more involved in the CYO Boosters this year. CYO Band & Orchestra is a non-profit [501(c)(3)] organization that relies on an executive board of volunteers to operate. You are all very dedicated parents. You not only care about how your children are doing in school, but you volunteer with your Home and School organization, you coach your kids' sports teams and you do anything else you believe will help your students succeed. While we realize that not everyone can take a leadership role on the Board, we would ask you to volunteer as much as you are able and perhaps attend a meeting or two. The CYO Boosters generally meet on the second Monday of every month at 6:00 PM in the CYO Band room. If you are interested in assisting in any way please contact me.

The fee also includes a lesson once a week during the school day for 4th & 5th grade <u>beginners</u>. We currently plan to start these lessons the week of Sept. 25th, but that could change if there are delays.

After School Band rehearsals (experienced 5th grade and up) will be scheduled two days each week after school <u>at the CYO Band Room in St. Joseph Upper Campus</u>. The after school band performs 4 concerts per year. The rehearsal times and days are being worked out and you will receive more details

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at the Parent Information Meeting. We will confirm details at a later date, but if you have any questions you can contact me sooner. The cost to attend after school band will be \$175.00. This is to cover the cost of music, equipment and band room rental.

Thanks to the generosity of the Bob and Cathy Willems family and your fundraising efforts, *every returning student* will have the opportunity to receive a scholarship to offset a part of their membership dues. Details on how to apply for the **Bob Willems Memorial Scholarship** for CYO Band will be provided at the "Back to School Night" Parent Information Meetings.





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Dear All Saints Catholic School Families,

As you may know, the Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) Band & Orchestra offers lessons and rehearsals to ASCS beginning students (4th & 5th grade), rehearsals for Cadet students (5th & 6th with 2-3 years experience), and Middle School students (6th, 7th, & 8th with 3 or more years experience). For students with 2 or more years of experience (5th grade and up) the CYO also has an after school band program that will meet two days a week at St. Joseph Catholic Academy – Upper Campus in the CYO band room.

In addition the school will offer a choir program. All three ensemble rehearsals will take place on the same day (TBD). *Each student MUST select one of the three ensembles to participate in*. Band and orchestra beginner students will also receive one individual or small-group lesson per week during the school day. Both band and orchestra will be offered for an additional cost of \$200.00 which includes lessons for beginners. This fee is to help cover the cost of equipment, music, and other expenses to conduct the program. These fees do not include instrument rental. Instruments may be rented through local music business like Pacetti's Music. After school band is \$175.00 There is no additional cost for students selecting choir.

New Students

All 4th and 5th grade students have the opportunity to choose between Band, Orchestra, and Choir. There is a \$200 registration fee for band & orchestra that covers the entire year. This includes a 30 minute lesson each week (beginner students only) and a 45 minute band rehearsal. This registration form will get your student all signed up for Band and Orchestra. You should bring this form, along with your student, to the Parent Information Meeting at your respective school. At the meeting you will have the opportunity to ask questions about the program, as well as get your child scheduled to be fitted for an instrument. Each instrument fitting will take approximately 10 minutes. These fittings will take place within a week of the meeting and are extremely important so we can make sure your student is physically able to play their instrument.
